and altar servers for the church during mass and funerals. One of our members prepares the sanctuary and the gifts
for the Sunday Mass each week.**

**Various members have been very committed during the year to visiting the sick at home, in hospital and in nursing
home. During the year our council members have been involved in planning and/or participating in various events
including the following:**

- ▶ **Placed a Remembrance Day wreath at Borden Legion Service for Remembrance day**
- ▶ **Hosted in joint effort with the CWL the Seven Mile Bay Annual Parish Pilgrimage**
- ▶ **Council held prayers for the "Our Lady of Charity" Icon and ensured transportation to the next council**
- ▶ **Prepared and supplied treats as we do annually to be given out to approximately 100 children during Santa's
Visit at the Church Christmas Concert, Seven Mile Bay**
- ▶ **Council helped arrange and participate in the Ark of the new Covenant Ceremonies at two of our Parishes
and Members provided transportation to receive the Ark, set up at two parish's and deliver and setup for
the next council's parish. One member was also involved in the pickup and transportation of the ark as it
reached the island from the mainland and the return of a trailer it came on.**
- ▶ **Made donations to various organizations and groups throughout the year**
- ▶ **And Finally one of our greatest accomplishments over the year was the construction of a new wheelchair
ramp which was build to the specifications of the Council of the Disabled. This was done upon approval of
the parish council. The complete project was built by members of the council and is planned to be painted
by members of the council in the summer of 2008. This project is expected to have saved the parish an
estimated seven to eight thousand dollars.**
