Council Report ~ 2006-2007

On behalf of T.P. Butler Council, I wish to submit the following report on our activities for the past year:

- The Council continues to sponsor and promote our Vocations Chalice program, with a new family receiving the chalice each month.
- Council raised approximately \$1500⁰⁰ from our annual Community Calendar. Through the sale of approximately 325 calendars, we provide the local area with enjoyable birthday, marriage, and memorial reminders; and the revenue helps us to assist our parishes and communities.
- Council presented rosaries to First Communicants in our parishes of St. Lawrence and St. Theresa.
- In conjunction with the CWL, Council presented Crucifixes to the Confirmation Class of our parishes.
- Council donated money to Morell Regional High School's graduation; and, in conjunction with the CWL and with St. Lawrence & St. Theresa parishes, presented each Catholic graduate with a Bible.
- Members volunteered their time at the annual St. Lawrence O'Toole Picnic.
- Council began renovations to the base of the statue of the Blessed Mother in Little Flower Grotto—and will complete the work this summer.
- Members continue to active in the parish as members of parish committees, as seat collectors, lectors, servers; and many spend weekly time in our perpetual-adoration chapel.
- Council sponsored a pre-Lenten Pancake & Sausage Breakfast and raised \$300.
Council donated \$250 to the parish catechism program.
- Council once again erected its **Keep Christ in Christmas** sign in the village center, and members displayed personal Keep Christ in Christmas lawn signs.
- Council donated \$100 to the Upper Room Hospitality Ministry.
Council donated \$100 to Birthright P.E.I.
- Council donated \$100 to the Alzheimers' Association of P.E.I.
- Council donated \$100 to a parish youth for a faith-related project
- Council donated \$50 to the QEH Foundation.
- Council donated \$500 to those in need.
- Council continues to purchase K of C pamphlets for the pamphlet displays, donated to our parishes in 2001.
